Born in Israel at Kibbutz Shaar Hamaakin, Rina studied at Bezallel art and craft college in Jerusalem, and then returned to teach at the Kibbutz.

She started her work at the studio of master ceramist Hana Zunz and has become distinguished as one of Israel's leading ceramic artists.

Her awards comprise a broad spectrum from cookware to magnificent menorahs. Among her many shows, her solo exhibit in Tel Aviv was sponsored by Mrs. Ruth Dayan. Her pieces have been chosen for the home of the Israeli President.

Now, in the short time Rina Peleg has been in the U.S., she has achieved recognition as one of the truly talented and highly unique artists working in the medium of clay.
